Texture ID Groups & Product Determination

- Texture Types:
  - Straight with/without Bend,
  - Waves (loose, defined, deep)
  - o Curls (loose, defined, tight)
  - o Coils (loose, defined, tight)
  - Afro-Coils (loose coils/zig zag, tight coils/zig zag, tight zig zag and loose zig zag)

Texture Patterns: S-Patterns, C-Patterns, Z (Zig-Zag Patterns)

#### Hair Pattern Descriptions:

- A curl is a **C pattern** with a loose to tight spiral formation.
- A coil is a very tight to extremely tight curl with a C pattern. It has a spiral formation and when lengthened or stretched, resembles a series of loops. All hair has some texture whether, it is straight and coarse with a bend or Afro coils— highly textured hair.
- An Afro-coil is a combination of a C pattern and a Z pattern (zigzag) that can be fine hair strands with very tight or very loose Z patterns and a lot of frizz and volume.
- A wave is a **S pattern** with a loose to deep bend forming into a curvy formation.
- Straight hair has **no bend or a slight bend.**

# **PRODUCT GROUP I – Straight, Waves & Loose Curls**

Straight: no bend, slight bend Waves: loose waves, defined waves, deep waves Curls: loose curls

**Pattern:** No bend to slight bend forming into a loose S and very loose round C formation. Hair that is straight and loose waves typically grow straight from the scalp and lack volume at the root. Defined waves and loose curls start bending mid shaft and

#### Products:

- hydration and water-based (H2O) work well with all textures.
- water based products with humectants: ingredients like aloe, flaxseed gel, honey, and vegetable glycerin
- products with a light-weight consistency work best
- with these textures.

### **PRODUCT GROUP II - CURLS & COILS**

**CURLS**: defined curls and tight curls **COILS**: loose coils, defined coils, and tight coils

**Pattern:** Medium to tight **C formations** with big and small loops to tight spirals. Hair grows out from the scalp and has medium to heavy volume and frizz.

## Products:

• a combination of water-based products, humectants, butters, botanical and essential oils

• a medium to heavy consistency work well for textured styling.

# PRODUCT GROUP III - Afro-Coils / Highly Textured Hair Combination patterns

Loose Coil with Zig Zag pattern Tight Coil with Zig Zag pattern Tight Zig Zag pattern – on z patterns Loose Zig Zag patterns - stretched out is wiry straight

Pattern: Very tight C formations and (Z) Zig Zag formations with very tight spirals to only Z patterns with loose, fine, course or wiry strands

# Products:

- rich butters, botanicals, and essential oils
- Heavy and thick consistency work well on course textures
- Medium consistency works better of fine and thin hair for textured styling
- Medium consistency works better for smoothing and straightening.
